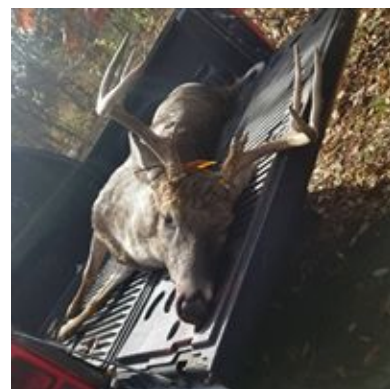
September came an amazing elk hunt in Cahone, Colorado. Although no tags were filled, the event was a great success thanks to our hosts, the Stowe Family.
